Diversity & Inclusion

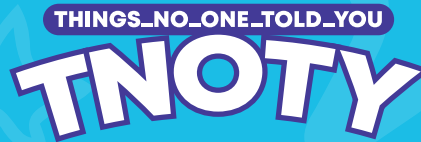
Supporting and connecting local LGBTIQ+ young people through school-based Pride Groups. This includes guest speakers, resources, information and project support.
